Beans, Bush	Tendergreen, Blue Lake, Kentucky Runner, Roma, Blue Lake 274, Bronco, Half-Runners	50 to 60	July 15 <sup>th</sup> – August 15 <sup>th</sup>
Beans, Pole	Blue Lake, Dade, Kentucky Blue, Moccasin, Extender, Improved Tendergreen	50	July 15 <sup>th</sup> – August 15 <sup>th</sup>
Beans, Lima	Henderson Bush, Bridgeton, Fordhook 242, Jackson Wonder	65 to 75	July 1st – August 1st
Beets	Detroit Red, Ruby Queen, Red Ace	55 to 65	August 5 <sup>th</sup> – September 1 <sup>st</sup>
Broccoli	Marathon, Packman, Patriot, Premium Crop, Bravo, Decathlon, Waltham 29	60 to 70	Seed Indoors – July 25 <sup>th</sup> – August 1 <sup>st</sup> Outdoor – August 15 <sup>th</sup> – Sept. 1st
Butter peas	Dixie	70	July 1 <sup>st</sup> – August 1 <sup>st</sup>
Cabbage	Market Prize, Red Acre, Blue Dynasty, Bravo, Early Round Dutch, Rio Verde, Green Jewel, A&C No. 5	65 to 80	August 25 <sup>th</sup> – September 15 <sup>th</sup>
Carrot	Nantes, Scarlet – Half long type, Chantenay, Scarlet Nantes, Sweet Bites, Sweet Delight, Thumbelina (small)	70 to 80	Late July – September 1st
Cauliflower	Absolute, Early Snowball, Graffiti, White Magic, Symphony	60 to 75	July 15 – August 15th

Cucumber – All varieties	Marketmore, Straight Edge, Sweet Slice, Sweet Success, Burpless Hybrid, Diva	60 to 65	August 1st to August 15th
Eggplant	Black Beauty, Classic, Dusky, Ghost Buster's, Calliope	75-90	July 10 <sup>th</sup> – July 30th
Garlic	Purple Stripe, Porcelain, Racombole, Artichoke, Silverskin	180 to 220	October 1 <sup>st</sup> – November 10 <sup>th</sup>
Kale	Vates, Dwarf Siberian, Blue Armor, Blue Knight	50 to 70	August 1 <sup>st</sup> – September 1st
Lettuce	Butterhead, Romaine, Buttercrunch, Bibb, Oak Leaf, Simpson	60 to 80	August 25 <sup>th</sup> – September 15 <sup>th</sup>
Onion – green	White Portugal, Crystal Wax	100 to 120	August 25 – September 15 <sup>th</sup>
Onion – dry bulb	Burgundy, Excel, Granex, Red Creole, Savannah Sweet	100 to 120	October 10 <sup>th</sup> – November 10 <sup>th</sup>
Pepper – Bell	Big Bertha, Camelot x3a, Colossal, Karma	65- to 70	July 25 <sup>th</sup> – August 10th
Potato – Irish	Red LaSoda, Red Pontiac, Sequoia, White(Yukon Gold, Atlantic, Kennebec)	80 to 90	July 15 <sup>th</sup> – August 1 <sup>st</sup>
Radish	Cherry Belle, Scarlet Globe, Champion	30	September 1 <sup>st</sup> – October 15 <sup>th</sup>
Spinach	Savoy, Dixie Market, Melody, Winter Bloomsdale, Hybrid#7	40 to 45	August 25 – September 15 <sup>th</sup>
Squash – Winter – (Plants)	Acorn, Butternut, Bonbon, Buttercup	70 to 110	August 1 <sup>st</sup> – August 25th
Turnip Greens	Seven Top, Purple Top, Royal Crown	45	August 15 – September 15 <sup>th</sup>
Tomato Plants	Better Boy, Homestead, (any V-F-N Hybrid)	70 to 85	July 1 <sup>st</sup> – July 15 <sup>th</sup>

Note: In variety selection, learn the qualities of those available on the local market. Plant with the current weather conditions in your area. Planting dates should be used in conjunction with individual judgment and seasonal variations.
